

Questions and answers

Who is allowed to handle waste in Denmark?

Only companies that are registered in the Danish National Waste Register (Waste Register) are legally allowed to handle waste in Denmark.

How do I register my company in the Waste Register?

You can find a guide for registration on this website.

Which information am I required to provide?

You are required to provide information about the country of origin, address, phone number and VAT no of the company you represent. Furthermore, you are required to specify which category; the company should be registered in.

I am stuck during my application - what can I do?

Do I have to pay a registration fee?

All companies registered in the Waste Register are required to pay both a one-time registration fee and an annual fee. The table below contains an overview of the current fee levels.

**The approval and registration of collection companies is limited in time and is given for 5 years

The fees shall, cf. section 25 of the Executive Order on the Danish National Waste Register and approval as collector, correspond to the actual costs incurred by the Danish Energy Agency in connection with the establishment, operation, maintenance, and administration of the Waste Register, including costs associated with fee collection and supervision of companies subject to registration. The fees are adjusted annually as per January 1st.
